

Andhra Lutheran Mission Reunion Plans, May 2010

At our last Andhra Lutheran Mission Reunion in May 2008, everyone wanted to gather again at Lutheridge in May 2010. Now it's time to start some serious planning for our next reunion even though it's still a year away. Lutheridge opens their books for reservations thirteen months in advance of an event. That means, to be sure of whatever accommodations we want for May 2010, we need to request lodging in APRIL of THIS year, 2009. Lutheridge requires a 25% lodging deposit one month after an event has been tentatively reserved in order to hold the reservation. Please answer the following three questions in an email to Virginia Herlong, vherlong@sc.rr.com as soon as possible. We would like to put a report of your responses in the March Newsletter. Thank you for your participation!

1) Are you planning to attend the May 2010 reunion?

If so, who in your family, and will you be able to pay a lodging deposit (\$50 for a single or \$75 for a double) by May 2009 to Virginia so she can pay the initial 25% reservation to Lutheridge? Your deposit is refundable.

2) Which 2-3 days in May 2010 would you or would you not be able to come? (Also, please indicate whether you would prefer weekdays or the weekend.)

3) Where would you like to stay? (Prices are the 2009 nightly rates and may increase in 2010.)

- KOHNJOY INN: 16 motel-type rooms, each with two double beds and private bath
\$77/single, \$88/double
- THORNBURG HALL: 35 rooms in two-room suites with connecting bath (four rooms have private bath)
\$52/single, \$71/double, or \$99/suite if immediate family
- BACOT CENTER: a bi-level house that accommodates up to 15 people (8 bedrooms) with two bathrooms on each floor
\$40/person, or a minimum rate of \$320/house if less than 8 people
- CARLA and H&H COTTAGES: each cottage can sleep up to 12 people with two sets of bunk beds in each of three bedrooms, with one bath per cottage
\$31/person, or a minimum rate of \$155/cottage if less than 5 people
- LAKESIDE VILLAGE (6 cabins): each cabin can sleep up to 10 people with two sets of bunk beds in each of two bedrooms, each with private bath
\$28/person, or a minimum rate of \$112/cabin if less than 4 people

Kohnjoy, Thornburg and Bacot have linens provided. The cottages and cabins have an optional bed and bath linen charge of \$9/bed. Bacot, Carla, H&H and Lakeside have kitchen facilities.
